# SUBMISSION GUIDELINES:

All submissions must be RECEIVED by midnight Friday, April 21, 2023.

If you are unable to apply online, you may submit the print version of the application with your cheque. Please contact the organizer: Silvana Michetti smichetti5@gmail.com directly before submitting a written application

• Applicants must be Toronto Potters members in good standing, with dues paid for the spring application process through the exhibition dates until the end of December 2023.

- Entry Fee: \$40 (non-refundable) online application payment
- Each participant may submit up to 3 entries. Individual pieces not to exceed 30 lbs.
- Each participant must submit a biography (200 word maximum).
- All pieces must be for sale. The artist sets the retail price. Sets and series must be labeled/priced as one piece.
- Only works in which clay is the major component will be considered.
- Work(s) must have been made within the past 2 years and not have been exhibited previously in a juried show.

• Work(s) submitted to the Gardiner Museum exhibition must be actual works selected by the jurors. Replicas will not be accepted. Toronto Potters reserves the right to refuse any work differing from the original.

### APPLICATION DEADLINE: Your application must be received before midnight, Friday April 21, 2023

- Measure and weigh your piece(s) maximum weight not to exceed 30 lbs.
- Prepare your 200 -word biography/artist statement

  - \$40 Entry fee application payment
  - Completed Entry Form (includes Title, description, material/medium, weight, measurements in cm., Retail price)
  - Biography (200-word max.)

#### **JURY PROCESS:**

Delivery of work for jury process: Friday, May 5th, 2023, 9 am - 8 pm to Toronto Potters Studio

Find street parking or park in the curved driveway at the north side of the building for 10 minutes to drop off your work The building can be entered from the north door on Argyle Street <u>or</u> the main door on Shaw Street. The loading ramp at the north door leads to the main door elevator. Take elevator to the first floor to Studio 107. You will unpack your submission(s) and take packing home with you.

- The selection made by jurors is final.
- You will pack your own submissions with your own packing materials.
- Professional photographs of selected work will be emailed to participants by the end of May.

## THE EXHIBITION:

October 4<sup>th</sup>, 2023, to January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2024 -The Gardiner Museum Shop, 111 Queens Park, will be hosting **MIND AND MATTER: the Toronto Potters 22nd Biennial Exhibition** 

- **Summer 2023** Artists will have received an Artist Consignment Agreement Package from the Gardiner Museum with delivery and invoicing instructions
- October 3, 2023, 11:00 am. Exhibitors deliver selected works to the Gardiner Museum.
- October 11<sup>th</sup>, 2023, 6:00 8:00 pm. Opening Reception and Awards Presentation in the Terrace Room
- The gallery will be responsible for insuring all work for theft and damage while on gallery premises. The insurance value is determined at 55% of the total <u>retail value</u> of the work as specified in the Application Form.
- Toronto Potters and the Gardiner Museum will not be responsible for insuring work during shipping to and from the premises.
- Consignment Payments for any work sold during the Exhibition (50% for the exhibitor and 50% for the gallery) will be made within 30 days of the exhibition closing date as per the Gardiner Museum Consignment Agreement.
- **January 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2024**: Pickup of unsold work. Arrangements may be made for some work to be retained in the Shop retail inventory.
- The selling price of the work is exclusive of any applicable taxes. HST will only be paid if the HST registration number is provided.
- Acceptance into the exhibition grants permission to Toronto Potters and the Gardiner Museum the right to use digital images for possible reproduction in all promotional material, critical reviews of the exhibition, archival storage relating to the history of Toronto Potters and the gallery's exhibitions, and for promoting future projects
